To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate up to \$15,000 to be added to the existing Special Education Expendable Trust Fund for educating educationally disabled children, with such amount to be funded from the June 30, 2014 unreserved fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2014? The School Board and the Budget Committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required) Note: (This sum is to come from the unreserved fund balance and no amount to be raised from taxation.) To see if the School District will vote to create an expendable trust fund under the provisions of RSA 198:20-c, to be known as the Generator Fund, for the purpose of purchasing and installing a generator for the Barnard School to protect the plumbing/heating systems in the event of a power outage? Furthermore, to raise and appropriate up to \$10,000 to be placed in the Generator Fund with such amount to be funded from the June 30, 2014 unreserved fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2014 and to name the School Board as agents to expend from the Generator Fund.
